Session 2015-16

IICE (Indian Institute of Computer Education) has been providing training to the students (in different streams)of this college since 2013 in computer courses – O level & CCC registered under DOEAC Society now known as NIELT . An Orientation Programme was held by teaching faculty Mrs. Sonal Malhotra 23/7/15 on “Advantages of Computer Learning in current Scenario”. The students enrolled under these courses get easily selected in govt. /private jobs.

KVC consultant held Placement Drive in the college on 2/2/2016 under which 115 students of different participated in SWOT (Strength Weaknesses opportunities Talents) exercise on themselves . Though the results were not much satisfactory, they got valuable inputs from their staff with regard to the attributes which may help them in securing good jobs in Govt./ Private sector.

TCS , like previous years held its online placement drive in which four students qualified online written test on 25/8/15 but they were not intimidated about the interview. The company send intimation to the college regarding their online test via emails which is further intimated to the students from the college via sms & posting the details on college website.

Session 2016-17

The career/ Placement cell of the college invited various Companies /Firms/NGOs in the college campus to apprise students of various sectors like Aviation, Software industry, Banking, Government, Private jobs etc. Like the previous sessions the cell has held 2 Orientation programmes in the academic session 2016-17 under the banner ‘PATHWAY TO GREAT JOBS’

The schedule of the two programmes is as under.

- 1- ‘TEAM SATYAM’ organised workshop which included the trend & the process to achieve the Government & Private Sectors Jobs on 30-08-2016
- 2- ‘Frankinn Institute of Airhostess Training’ conducted ‘student Development Program’ which included carrier in Airlines, Hotel & travel industry on 06-09-2016.



In the meantime, alumni of this institution who are well placed in different Govt./Private organization are invited to give their valuable inputs related to written & interview competitive exams to the present students of the college. This practice has really worked wonders to our students in getting through various competitive exams.

In the session 2013-14,

Five students successfully cleared written exam conducted by Tata Consultancy Ltd. and all of them passed the interview exam held at Gurgaon. They were given the initial package of 1.2 lacs per annum but they did not finally joined as they wanted to pursue higher studies. They will complete their M.Sc (Statistics) course in the session 2015-16. Their names are as under-

In the Session 2014-15, out of 10 applicants who took online written exam conducted by T.C.S and were pursuing B.Sc (S.P.M group) in this college, only four of them have cleared the exam, they are awaiting their interview call, to be intimated by the Company shortly in the near future. Unfortunately, the information of the written exam reached the college authority one day prior to the date of the written exam in the summer vacation, so most of the students could not participate in it. Since the online exam are held twice (June & December) in every year as per the vacancy in the company, the college has provided the contact details of final year graduation students along with the e-mail ID of the co-ordinator so that maximum students can avail the benefit of this placement facility.

Moreover, out of the three passouts (B.Sc –SPM gp-2014-15 session)who were called for interview exam held by TCS, only one student, Pranshi Mishra got the final placement with an initial package of 1.8 lacs per annum & first posting at Tiruvananthapuram. She visited the campus in August, 2015 to share her experiences with the present Batches (SPM& PCM)of the college.

The college has provided within the campus facility to train specifically the final year students for securing jobs in the present scenario keeping in view the challenges faced in the job market. This responsibility was entrusted with an **NGO- Medha** who gave their valuable training to 87 students of 2013-14 & 2014-15 sessions & gave hands-on training in different firms ,Media houses etc. (Medha report attached) . The assessment of these students is also given by the organization (encl. attached). 47 students ,who successfully completed the program received National Skills Development Corporation (NSDC) certificates at the graduation ceremony organized on 18 February, 2015. Mr. Jayant Krishna, Principal Consultant with Tata Consultancy Services attended the event. In the ceremony, he spoke about the vitality of "Basic Computer Literacy" and "Spoken English" in the corporate world today. Medha students shared their experiences of Medha program and the impact that it made on their lives. Graduation ceremony marked the end of 2014-15 training session of Medha program in the college and the beginning of 2015-16 session.

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
