MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
BETWEEN
NAVYUG KANYA MAHAVIDYALAYA
AND
MEDHA

The MOU is made on the 01.09.2017 day of 31.01.2018 month in the year 2017, at Lucknow, between NAVYUG KANYA MAHAVIDYALAYA, 218, Rajendra Nagar, Lucknow, a government-aided degree college affiliated to University of Lucknow, which is officially represented by the Principal, and include her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the "First Party"

AND

MEDHA LEARNING FOUNDATION (hereinafter referred as Medha), 407, Dr. Baijnath Road, New Hyderabad, Lucknow, a not-for-profit Company under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956, which is officially represented by the Executive Director, and include his successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the "Second Party"



WHEREAS

The Second Party shall be implementing an Employability Development Programme (the "Programme"), by delivering Structured Training Modules (Bootcamps) to the students in batches, on the campus of the First Party.

1. COMMENCEMENT, COMPLETION, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF THIS MOU

- 1.1 This MOU shall come into force from the date of signing, or other earlier date that is mutually agreed by the two parties.
- 1.2 Modification of the terms and conditions of this MOU may only be made through mutual agreement between the parties.
- 1.3 The MOU shall be valid for one year from the date of signing. The results and outcomes of the Programme are subject to review every year by either party. The terms of the MOU may be reviewed/modified after the Annual Programme Review.
- 1.4 The MOU may be mutually terminated at any time, if the Programme fails to produce desired results and outcomes, and/or if either party fails to perform its role or meet its obligations as mentioned in the MoU (below):

2. ROLE & OBLIGATION OF THE SECOND PARTY IN SUPPORT OF PROGRAMME

- 2.1 The Trainings offered under the Programme within the premises of the College shall be delivered exclusively to the students of the College.
- 2.2 The Programme this year shall comprise 30 Hrs of Career Advancement Bootcamp (CAB) training focusing on career skills, to the eligible/interested students.
- 2.3 The Training (Bootcamps) shall be delivered by personnel appointed by Medha during the course of the Programme.
- 2.4 The Programme shall not be offered free of cost. The Programme shall be chargeable on the basis of Rs. 500 per student for CAB. The receipt of any such amount would be properly documented and shared with the student and the College.
- 2.5 Medha shall reimburse the College, 10% of the total fee collected from the students, to cover the associated overhead costs of the College.
