This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING no. MLF-2014-003 (the "MOU"), dated March 25, 2014, records the understanding arrived by and between:

- (1) Medha Learning Foundation, incorporated under the laws of India with its registered address at 407, Dr. Baijnath Road, New Hyderabad, Lucknow-226007 and incorporated as a not-for-profit company under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956 (the "Foundation"); and
- (2) Navyug Kanya Mahavidyalaya, located at Rajendra Nagar, Lucknow – 226004, and associated with Lucknow University as a government-aided college (the "College");

For enabling the implementation of a specific Employability Development Programme (the "Programme") by the **Foundation**, for the students of, and within the physical premises of the **College**, and, with the intent of setting forth a broad framework of collaboration, allocation of responsibilities, and a joint consultation and review framework, in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- (1) The **Foundation** has partnered with the **College** to deliver the **Programme** exclusively to the students of the **College**.
- (2) The **Programme** shall provide skills training, mentorship, and career services to the students at the **College** in order to improve their employment outcomes.

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- (3) The **Programme** shall run for 90 days and shall constitute 180 hours of classroom interaction and 100 hours of homework assignments.
- (4) The **Programme** shall also constitute 120 hours of on-the-job-training for students spanning over 1 month under the **Programme**.
- (5) The **Foundation** shall charge the students a lump sum fee of Rs. 2500 for the services delivered under the **Programme**. Neither the **College** nor the **Foundation** shall charge the students anything above and beyond this amount, in any manner whatsoever, for the services delivered under the **Programme** in the current year.
- (6) The **Foundation** shall follow an admissions process that includes student workshops, registration, orientation, and finally enrolment of students in the **Programme** from the overall student body at the **College**.
- (7) The **Foundation** is expected to run at least one batch of a minimum of 30 students at the **College** and/or at most two batches of a maximum of 50 students in each batch in the current year.
- (8) The **Programme** shall run in-class activities and exercises with the students on all working days at the **College**, for 90 days, 2 hours each day, during a fixed time period mutually agreed upon in consultation with the **College**.
- (9) The **College** shall provide the **Foundation** access to classroom space, one per batch, during the designated hours of the **Programme**.
- (10) The **College** shall provide a temporary workplace to **Foundation** to manage and coordinate the **Programme** at the **College**.
- (11) The **College** shall provide access to the **Foundation** for organising student events on campus, related to the **Programme**, planned in advance and in consultation with the **College**.
- (12) The **Foundation** shall provide computer hardware, software, and internet access to students as and when required by the **Programme**.
- (13) The **Foundation** shall reimburse the **College**, an amount equal to ten percent of the total fees collected by the **Foundation** from the students for the **Programme**. This reimbursement is for incremental overhead expenses incurred by the **College** associated with the **Programme**.
- (14) Both the **Foundation** and the **College** shall nominate a single contact person to jointly consult, plan, execute, and monitor the **Programme** at the **College**.
- (15) The **College** shall render full support and cooperation to the best of the available resources, to the **Foundation** in all aspects of the **Programme** to ensure an effective and efficient delivery to the students.
- (16) The **Foundation** shall ensure that it adheres to the norms of the **College** and shall act in the best interest of the students.







- (17) There shall be no financial implication on either side or monetary exchange in any form between the **College** and the **Foundation**, apart from what is mentioned and agreed upon herewith the **MOU**.
- (18) The **Foundation** has partnered with government colleges in Lucknow, viz. Maharaja Bijli Pasi Govt. PG College and Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Govt PG College, and government-aided college in Lucknow, viz. Avadh Girls Degree College, under the **Programme**. The **Programme** has been introduced by Secretary of Higher Education, Government of Uttar Pradesh and the **Foundation** is a partner institution of National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), New Delhi. The credentials of the **Foundation** may be verified at the above institutions.

The **MOU** shall be effective for 12 months from the date of signing, upon completion of which, shall be open for review by both the parties, and may be extended/renewed further, upon mutual agreement.
